



PUBLIC CONSULTATION

Anglesey Aluminium proposes to construct and operate a Renewable Energy Plant (REP) on land within the boundary of the existing aluminium smelter at Penrhos Works, south east of Holyhead, Anglesey.

Anglesey Aluminium Metal Renewables Ltd, a subsidiary of Anglesey Aluminium Metal Limited, has made an application under Section 36 of the Electricity Act, 1989 to construct and operate a 299MW Renewable Energy Plant. The application to the Department of Energy and Climate Change is accompanied by an Environmental Statement. The Environmental Statement has been prepared by Parsons Brinckerhoff Ltd and details the results of a comprehensive study of the environmental impacts of the proposed Renewable Energy Plant.

A public exhibition has been organised so that interested members of the public can take a closer look at the project proposals and discuss the plans on a one-to-one basis.
